ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For entry onto the OTHM Level 5 Diploma in Information Technology qualification, learners must possess:

Relevant NQF/QCF/RQF Level 4 Diploma or equivalent

Learner must be 18 years or older at the beginning of the course

English requirements: If a learner is not from a majority English-speaking country must provide evidence of English language competency.





EQUIVALENCES

OTHM qualifications at RQF Level 5 represent practical knowledge, skills, capabilities and competencies that are assessed in academic terms as being equivalent to Foundation Degrees, Higher National Diploma (HND) and Year 2 of a three-year UK Bachelor's degree.



DURATION AND DELIVERY

The qualification is designed to be delivered over one academic year for full-time study, but it is also flexible in its delivery in order to accommodate part-time and distance learning.

The qualification is delivered face-to-face, through lectures, tutorials, seminars, distance, online by LCHS.



ASSESSMENT

All units within this qualification are internally assessed by the LCHS and externally verified by OTHM.

The qualifications are criterion referenced, based on the achievement of all the specified learning outcomes.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

The OTHM Level 5 Diploma in Information Technology consists of 6 mandatory units for a combined total of 120 credits, 1200 hours Total Qualification Time (TQT) and 480 Guided Learning Hours (GLH) for the completed qualification.
