L6DIT Level 6 Diploma in Information & Technology

The objective of the OTHM Level 6 Diploma in Information Technology is to provide learners with the knowledge and skills to further their career in a range of organisations. It is designed to ensure that each learner is a confident, independent thinker with a detailed knowledge of Information Technology, and equipped with the skills to adapt rapidly to change at a junior or middle management level, and aspiring into higher management within their organisation or industry. The qualification is ideal for those who have started, or are planning to move into, a career in private or public sector business. Successful completion of the Level 6 Diploma in Information Technology will provide learners with the opportunity to progress to further study or employment.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For entry onto the OTHM Level 6 Diploma in Information Technology qualification, learners must possess:

- » Relevant NQF/QCF/RQF Level 5 diploma or equivalent recognised qualification
- » Learner must be 18 years or older at the beginning of the course
- » English requirements: If a learner is not from a majority English-speaking country must provide evidence of English language competency.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

The OTHM Level 6 Diploma in Information Technology consists of 6 mandatory units for a combined total of 120 credits, 1200 hours Total Qualification Time (TQT) and 480 Guided Learning Hours (GLH) for the completed qualification.
